I am writing in support of the Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP) grant application submitted by Surry County, Virginia.

I represent the Fourth Congressional District of Virginia, an area that comprises Surry County in Southeast Virginia. Surry County is a rural community that lacks access to local retail supermarkets and shopping resources. Located in what is known as a Strike Force Zone with a total population of 7,058 and an unemployment rate of 5.2%, Surry County is a food desert with many of its residents lacking access to fresh produce or grocery stores. Therefore, there is a great need for local farmers and agricultural producers to provide fresh produce for their community.

The funding awarded from the FMPP grant will help Surry County expand much-needed access to fresh produce. The funds awarded under the FMPP grant application will help increase participation in the purchasing and selling of fresh produce by increasing awareness and visitation to the farmers market, increasing vendor participation, and increasing the number of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) transactions.
